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Eligibility & Application Instructions

OVERVIEW

Up to six \$500 scholarships, paid as a one-time award, are available to seniors performing in NCBA Winter Activities (Guard, Percussion, Winds, Drum Major) during the current Winter Season. With a foundation rooted in education, NCBA is committed to recognizing all of its stakeholders – in this case, outstanding seniors who are deserving of receiving a monetary scholarship toward college expenses.

Applications are due Saturday, March 22, 2025, by midnight.

Scholarship winners will be announced at Championships.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The student must be a graduating senior who actively participated this season in an NCBA Winter Guard, Winter Percussion, Winter Winds, or as a Solo Drum Major.
- 2. The student's director must be a member of the NCBA.
- 3. The student must have achieved a minimum grade point average (GPA) of a 3.0 during their senior year, verified with an Official Grade Transcript.
- 4. The student must plan on continuing their academic studies in a college/university after graduating from high school.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Complete all sections of the Application Form and sign it.
- 2. Obtain and attach one current letter of recommendation from a teacher, mentor, or other professional.
- 3. Submit a typed one- to two-page essay (12-point font, double spaced, 1" margins) responding to the following prompt: *Describe your academic goals and how this scholarship will help you. Describe how being part of your high school music program has changed, influenced, or marked a milestone in your life.*
- 4. Attach a brief resume of your activities, awards, and experiences during your high school years.
- 5. Obtain and attach a current Official Grade Transcript signed by your school's registrar or designee.
- 6. Scan all documents and send your completed scholarship application "package" via email to <u>WinterActivities@ncbaonline.net</u>.

INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS, THOSE SUBMITTED WITHOUT ALL REQUIRED ATTACHMENTS, AND THOSE SUBMITTED AFTER THE DEADLINE WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.
